3. スキンケアの土台の定義

「適切な洗浄とバリアケアこそが、スキンケアの土台であり、肌の自活力を 最大限に引き出すための具体的な行動指針」という結論は、予防医学とし てのスキンケアの具体的な方法論を簡潔に示しており、ブレがありません。

●より強調できる点

この考え方をさらに強化するために:

1. 概念の具体化

「肌が本来持つ『健やかな状態を維持する機能(自活力)』」とは、具体的に「バリア機能」と「ターンオーバー」の2つが正常に働くことです。

2.「バリアケア」の再定義

This approach fundamentally lacks the perspective of fostering the skin's innate ability to become healthy (Self-Sustaining Power) and proactively preventing troubles.

The core philosophy of skincare is to maximize the skin's Self-Sustaining Power (Barrier Function and Cell Turnover) and prevent troubles. The foundational "method" for achieving this is "Appropriate Cleansing and Barrier Care."

Barrier Care redefines moisturizing: it does not view it as a simple "supply of water and oil (substitution)," but as care that stabilizes the structure of the intercellular lipids, prevents water loss, blocks the intrusion of external irritants, and ultimately prevents troubles.

This line of thinking captures the true essence of skincare deeply and clearly demonstrates the fundamental philosophy of skincare as a **"Preventive Medicine."**

Key Evaluation Points

1. Clear Separation of "Prevention" and "Treatment (Reaction)"

It is crucial and clear that the common, reactive goals consumers pursue—such as "eliminating dryness" or "concealing troubles"—are categorized as **Intensive Care/First Aid (Treatment)**, not true fundamental skincare. This delivers a vital message prompting consumer awareness reform.

2. Contrast Between "Self-Sustaining Power" and "Substitution"
The criticism is sharp: recognizing moisturizing as a mere "supply of water and oil (substitution)" leads to a "just apply and you're done" mentality, which neglects the perspective of enhancing the skin's intrinsic Self-Sustaining Power and preventing issues. The core misunderstanding in modern skincare is addressed here.

The assertion that true skincare is not mere "substitution" but about "unlocking the skin's self-sustaining power to nurture its ability to hydrate and protect itself and prevent troubles" is highly compelling.

3. Defining the Skincare Foundation

The conclusion that "Appropriate Cleansing and Barrier Care are the foundation of skincare and the specific course of action to maximize the skin's self-sustaining power" concisely presents the methodology of skincare as a preventive medicine, maintaining absolute consistency in the argument.

Points for Further Emphasis

To reinforce this philosophy:

- Conceptual Concretization: The "skin's inherent function to maintain a healthy state (Self-Sustaining Power)" specifically refers to the normal operation of two core systems: the Barrier Function and Cell Turnover.
- Redefinition of "Barrier Care": By defining Barrier Care as "care
 that stabilizes the intercellular lipid structure, prevents water
 evaporation, blocks the intrusion of external irritants, and prevents
 troubles," it is made explicitly clear that this is not merely a method
 of "substitution."
